Your campground reservations for IOLA 2022 – July 7, 8, 9 – are confirmed!

With this letter confirmation letter, we are enclosing your rearview mirror hanger(s), campground rules and regulations, as well as a map of the campground. The mirror hanger is your vehicle pass for entrance to the Campground. It has (2) perforated tabs for wristbands. **NO ADMISSION PASSES WILL BE ISSUED AFTER TABS HAVE BEEN REMOVED.** The campground officially opens on Wednesday, July 6th, at 10:00 a.m. There will be NO entry to the campground prior to that time. As you approach Iola watch for signs on Hwy. 49 that will direct you to the Iola Car Show Campgrounds, located at: E2196 Johanson Road, Iola, WI 54945.

The 2022 Iola Car Show opens to the public at 6:00 a.m. Thursday, July 7th. Absolutely NO showgrounds entry will be permitted prior to that time – strictly enforced.

NEW GOLF CART LANE: Campers will have a designated path from the campground to the golf cart lane. You will be required to register for an official permit prior to using the golf cart lane. Rentals/Registration will be near Gate 1.

BUS SERVICE HOURS: Thurs. - Sat., 6:00 a.m.–7:00 p.m. Concert Bus Service is available at the conclusion of the concerts.

RULES & REGULATIONS – CAMPGROUNDS

The Iola Car Show has developed the following rules for the Campgrounds.

Failure to comply with these rules may be cause for immediate ejection without any refund of fees.

1. Be sure you are in the right space and do not infringe on your neighbor's space.
2. Keep vehicle travel down to an absolute minimum. The speed limit is 5 mph or less.
3. Exercise courtesy and take your appropriate turn when loading onto a bus. Do not push or crowd.
4. **At all times, grills and campfires must be contained and attended.** No open ground fires or bon fires are allowed. Fire rings are available at the Registration Office. A \$20.00 refundable deposit is required. Weather permitting, self-contained fires are allowed.
5. Ashes must be disposed of in clearly marked containers found throughout the campground.
6. If you are found to be burning pallets, wood with nails or screws, or glass, your site(s) will be revoked.
7. **NO selling permitted- including crafts, auto items, trucks, cars, or motor homes.**
8. All tents rented must be obtained through the Iola Car Show's exclusive tent supplier- Charnecke Tents, 715-341-6886. Those who own tents/membrane structures – (shade canopy/tent/umbrella/etc.) may erect them using CAUTION, carefully considering the matter of; obstructions, location, weather, wind exposure, access, exit and anchoring stability. Tents/membrane structures must be adequately roped, braced, and anchored to withstand the elements of weather and prevent against collapsing. **Owners will be solely responsible for any damages or injuries caused by the tents/membrane structures due to weather or any other unforeseen accidents.** Items must be labeled with owner's name, address, and phone number.
9. Units with an official permit may be operated during normal show hours (6:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.) within the boundaries of the designated path only. If the unit is found in any other location, during these hours, its permit will be revoked.
10. **Apart from rule #9 above, the only motorized vehicles allowed on the grounds are three or four-wheeled electric one passenger vehicles (mobility carts).** Golf carts and bicycles are allowed in the Swap Meet and Car Corral, between 6:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m., and the campground between 7:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. If you are caught abusing this policy, the privilege & vehicle will be revoked. All other vehicles motorized or non-motorized, including skateboards, are not allowed.
11. No pets allowed. *If you travel with a pet, they must be kept on leash and remain on your space at all times of the day/night.*
12. Recycling: Please recycle aluminum, glass and plastic in the cages/ bins provided. Place cardboard next to the receptacles. Trash bags are available at campground registration office. Please help in keeping your area clean.
13. **Political displays of any kind are not allowed,** including but not limited to signs, banners, for sale items or exhibits.
14. No paging except in cases of emergencies.
15. No disruptive generators or construction generators, radios, stereos, TV, loudspeakers, etc.
16. Use of obscene language, gestures and disorderly conduct is prohibited.
17. NO firearms, knives, crossbows, BB guns, or any other weapons are allowed.
18. No refunds will be given after June 1.
