

## CAMPGROUND RULES & REGULATIONS:

*The Iola Car Show has developed the following Campground rules. Failure to comply with these rules may result in immediate ejection without any refund of fees.*

1. Be sure you are in the right space and do not infringe on your neighbor's space.
2. Keep vehicle travel down to an absolute minimum. The speed limit is 5 mph or less.
3. Exercise courtesy and take your appropriate turn when loading onto a bus. Do not push or crowd.
4. Weather permitting, self-contained fires are allowed. **At all times, grills and campfires must be contained and attended.** No open ground fires, bon fires or fireworks are allowed. Fire rings are available at the Registration Office. A \$20.00 refundable deposit is required. Ashes must be disposed of in clearly marked containers found throughout the campground.
5. If you are found to be burning pallets, wood with nails or screws, or glass, your site(s) will be revoked.
6. NO selling permitted- *including but not limited to crafts, auto items, trucks, cars, or motor homes.*
7. Political displays of any kind are not allowed. Including but not limited to, signs, banners, for sale items or exhibits.
8. All use of electricity should be with properly grounded cords and equipment.
9. All tents rented must be obtained through the Iola Car Show's exclusive tent supplier- Charnecke Tents, 715-341-6886. Those who own tents/membrane structures – (shade canopy/tent/umbrella/etc.) may erect them using CAUTION, carefully considering the matter of; obstructions, location, weather, wind exposure, access, exit and anchoring stability. Tents/membrane structures must be adequately roped, braced, and anchored to withstand the elements of weather and prevent against collapsing. Owners will be solely responsible for any damage or injuries caused by the tents/membrane structures due to weather or any other unforeseen accidents. Items must be labeled with the owner's name, address, and phone number.
10. **Carts with an official permit may be operated during normal show hours (6:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.) within the boundaries of the designated path only. If the cart is found in any other location, during these hours, its permit will be revoked.**
11. Apart from rule #10 above, the only motorized vehicles allowed on the grounds are three or four-wheeled electric one passenger vehicles (mobility carts). Golf carts and bicycles are allowed in the Swap Meet and Car Corral, between 6:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m., and the campground between 7:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. If you are caught abusing this policy, the privilege & vehicle will be revoked. All other vehicles motorized or non-motorized, including skateboards, are not allowed.
12. No pets allowed. *If you travel with a pet, they must be kept on leash and remain in your space at all times of the day/night.*
13. Recycling: Please recycle aluminum, glass and plastic in the cages/ bins provided. Place cardboard next to the receptacles. Trash bags are available at campground registration office. Please help with keeping your area clean.
14. No paging except in cases of emergencies.
15. Quiet hours are from 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
16. No disruptive generators or construction generators, radios, stereos, TV, loudspeakers, etc.
17. Use of obscene language, gestures and disorderly conduct is prohibited.
18. NO firearms, crossbows, BB guns, or any other weapons are allowed. Neither may they be sold.
19. No refunds will be given after June 1.
20. Iola Old Car Show, Inc. assumes no responsibility for any damage or loss by fire, theft, weather, or any other course whatsoever.
