



OFFICIAL RULES; CAMPGROUNDS

The Iola Car Show has developed the following rules.

Failure to comply with these rules may result in immediate ejection from the show grounds without any refund of fees.

Campground Rules

1. Prior to set-up, be sure you are in the right space.
2. Stay within the parameters of your space and do not infringe on your neighbor's space.
3. All vehicles parked in the campground must have a mirror hanger displayed. A campground visitor pass will be issued for this purpose. To be in compliance, the vehicle owner must register at the campground office to pick up proper credentials. There is no charge for a visitor pass.
4. Keep vehicle traffic travel down to an absolute minimum. The speed limit is 5 mph or less.
5. Exercise courtesy, taking your appropriate turn when loading onto a bus. Do not push or crowd.
6. Grills and campfires must be contained and attended at all times. No open ground fires, bon fires or fireworks are allowed. Fire rings are available at the Registration Office. A \$20.00 refundable deposit is required.
7. Ashes must be disposed of in clearly marked containers found throughout the campground.
8. If you are found burning pallets, wood with nails/screws, or glass your site(s) will be revoked.
9. NO selling permitted in the Campgrounds- including but not limited to crafts, auto items, trucks, cars, motor homes, firearms, crossbows, BB guns, or any other weapons.
10. No food of any type, beverage, water, or ice may be sold, donated, or given free with purchase.
11. Iola logos or symbols are registered trademarks. Reproduction of these logos or symbols in any form or on any item is restricted to authorized vendors only.

Core Rules - All areas of the Iola Car Show grounds:

1. No pets allowed. Only ADA compliant service animals are allowed.
2. Carts with an official permit may be operated during normal show hours (6 a.m. – 6 p.m.) within the boundaries of the designated path only. If the cart is found in any other location, during these hours, its permit will be revoked at the discretion of Iola Staff or Security personnel.
3. Apart from rule #2 above, the only motorized vehicles allowed on the grounds are three or four-wheeled electric one passenger vehicles (mobility carts). Except for pedestrian traffic all other forms of transportation, motorized or non-motorized, are not allowed.
4. Golf carts and bicycles, without a permit, are allowed in the Swap Meet and Car Corral between 6 p.m. and 11 p.m., and the campground between 7 p.m. and 11 p.m.
5. Political displays are not allowed. Including but not limited to, signs, banners, for sale items or exhibits.
6. Use of obscene language, gestures and disorderly conduct is prohibited.
7. All use of electricity should be with properly grounded cords and equipment.
8. All tents rented must be obtained through the Iola Car Show's exclusive tent supplier- Charnecke Tents, 715-341-6886. Those who own tents/membrane structures – (shade canopy/tent/umbrella/etc.) may erect them using CAUTION, carefully considering the matter of obstructions, location, weather, wind exposure, access, exit and anchoring stability. Tents/membrane structures must be adequately roped, braced, & anchored to withstand the elements of weather & to prevent collapsing. Owners will be solely responsible for any damage or injuries caused by the tents/membrane structures due to weather or any other unforeseen accidents. Items must be labeled with the owner's name, address & phone number.
9. Recycling: Please recycle aluminum, glass and plastic in the cages/bins provided. Place cardboard next to the recycling receptacles.
10. Fire regulations must be strictly adhered to. No open fires or fireworks at any time.
11. No personal announcements will be made, except in cases of emergencies.
12. Quiet hours are from 11 p.m. - 6 a.m.
13. Disruptive noise will not be permitted; including but not limited to generators, construction generators, persons, and music. Violation notices will be issued at the discretion of Iola Staff or Security personnel.
14. Iola Old Car Show, Inc. assumes no responsibility for any damage or loss by fire, theft, weather, or any other course whatsoever.
15. No refunds will be given after June 1st.

Your registration for the 2025 Iola Car Show is confirmed! Enclosed you'll find the following items:

- ❖ Show location mirror hanger(s). This is your vehicle pass for entrance into the showgrounds.
- ❖ Wristbands. Vendors are entitled to receive (2) wristbands for the first space and (1) wristband for each space thereafter. **Please find the enclosed WRISTBANDS and keep them in a safe place!**
 - They must be worn on your wrist – no other location is acceptable.
 - You will not be allowed to enter the showgrounds without one – Please attach it prior to arriving.
 - **REPLACEMENT WRISTBANDS WILL NOT BE REISSUED.** Those without their wristbands will be required to purchase admission.

ARRIVAL

- ❖ The campground opens on Wednesday, July 9th at 10 a.m. There will be no entry prior to then.
 - **Only those who paid for Early Camping credentials will be allowed entry before that day & time.**
- ❖ If you arrive after 10 p.m., you will be unable to register for a campsite until 6 a.m. the next day.
- ❖ As you approach Iola watch for signs directing you to the Iola Car Show Campgrounds, located at: E2196 Johanson Road, Iola, WI 54945.
- ❖ The 2025 Iola Car Show opens to the public at 7 a.m. Thursday, July 10th and runs through Saturday, July 12th. **Absolutely NO Showgrounds entry will be permitted before 7 a.m. Thursday - strictly enforced.**

VISITOR PASS (VEHICLE PASS)

- ❖ All vehicles parked in the campground must have a mirror hanger displayed. A campground visitor pass will be issued for this purpose. To be in compliance, the vehicle owner must register at the campground office to pick up proper credentials. There is no charge for a visitor pass.
- ❖ Save time & register ahead of time by scanning this QR code and filling out the form:
 - Upon arrival, pick up your Visitor Pass mirror hanger at the campground office.



BUS SHUTTLES

- ❖ Operates 6 a.m. – 7 p.m. on a continuous loop to and from the campground, with pick up/drop off point at the Car Corral, Gate #16.
- ❖ Gate #3 Campground Shuttle: Operates 6 a.m. – 5 p.m. on a continuous loop to and from Gate #3 (Show Car area and Main Drag).

SHOWER HOUSES

- ❖ Free showers are available.
- ❖ Showers are closed each night between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.

PUMPING SERVICES

To schedule service, register at the campground office by 8:30 a.m. \$45 for a standard size tank - cash or check only. The service tech will collect payment.

- ❖ Thursday morning service 9:30am to 10:30am
- ❖ Friday morning service 9:30am to 10:30am
- ❖ Saturday morning service 9:30am to 10:30am
- ❖ **Final service line-up.** You do not need to register in advance. On your way out of the campgrounds a service tech will be available. Saturday: 3pm to 6pm and Sunday: 7am to 11am

GOLF CART PATH PERMIT - Carts with an official permit may be operated during normal show hours (6 a.m. – 6 p.m.). Permits can be obtained by going to the golf cart registration area, just north of Gate #1. If you have your own personal golf cart, and wish to operate it during show hours, it will require a \$50 permit. Golf Carts are available to rent from Jim's Golf Cars. Reservations are recommended, as there will be limited availability for onsite rentals. Go to: www.jimgsgolfcars.com or call 920.754.4175

MOBILITY CARTS - Three or four-wheeled electric one passenger vehicles (mobility carts) are allowed to travel throughout the entire grounds. There is no permit or approval process required to bring a personal mobility cart. You may also rent them through a third party - Vista Mobility. Reservations are recommended, as there will be limited availability for onsite rentals. Go to: www.vistamobility.net or call 262-677-2696.
